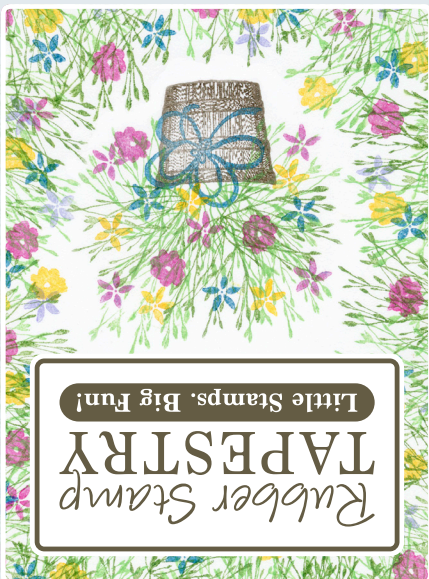

### Step-by-Step Instructions

1. Stamp the Block Barrel in pinecone in the center of the card.
2. Fill the barrel by stamping the Mini Grass in green tea & fresh green.
3. Stamp the Tiny Little Flower in opera pink.
4. Stamp the Tiny Simple Poinsettia in mountain lake, opera pink, & marigold.
5. Stamp the Mini Bow in mountain lake.
6. Create a border around the card by stamping the Mini Grass in green tea. Use the StampRight™ placement line to determine the position of the image. Clean the stamps each time before re-inking them with a new color.
7. Stamp the Mini Grass in fresh green.
8. Stamp the Tiny Little Flower in opera pink & marigold.
9. Stamp the Tiny Simple Poinsettia in opera pink, mountain lake & heliotrope.
