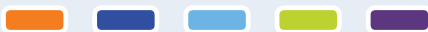

### Step-by-Step Instructions

1. Create a border around the card by stamping the Tiny Tulip in violet. Use the StampRight™ placement line to determine the position of the image. Clean the stamps each time before re-inking them with a new color.
2. Using an oval template, sponge with cyan.
3. Stamp the Bitty Square in lime around the oval.
4. Stamp the Mini Dots in cyan.
5. Stamp the Bitty Flower in royal blue & orange.
6. Stamp the Bitty Leaf in lime.
7. On a separate paper, stamp the Tiny Square in royal blue & cut out.
8. Stamp the Bitty Flower in violet, then orange.
9. Stamp the Bitty Leaf in lime. Cut out.
10. Glue the tile & flower grouping to the center of the oval.
