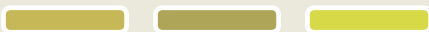

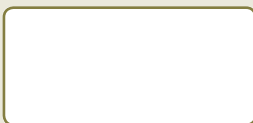

Step-by-Step Instructions

1. Stamp the Mini Prickly Pear Narrow Solid in split pea.
2. Using the StampRight™ placement line, stamp the Mini Prickly Pear Wide Solid in bamboo.
3. Stamp the Tiny Prickly Pear Narrow Solid in khaki.
4. Stamp the Tiny Prickly Pear Wide Solid in bamboo and again in split pea.
5. Creating another cactus, stamp the Mini Prickly Pear Solid Wide in bamboo.
6. Stamp the Tiny Prickly Pear Wide Solid in khaki and bamboo and the Prickly Pear Narrow Solid in split pea and khaki.
7. Create the desert with with light brown dye ink and the sky with light blue and yellow dye ink. Create shadows with gray pencil.
