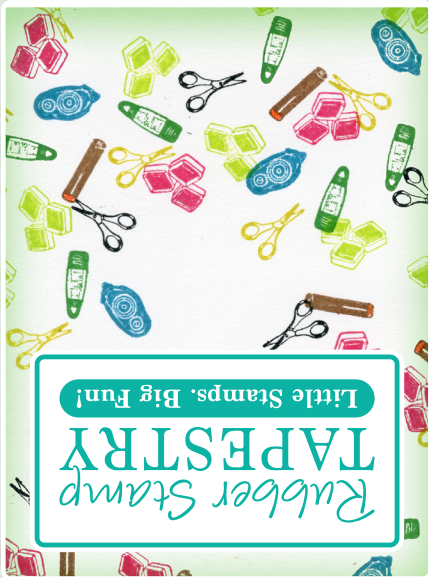

Step-by-Step Instructions

1. Stamp the Tiny Glue in green. Use the StampRight™ placement line to determine the position of the image. Rotate the stamp between impressions. Clean the stamps each time before re-inking them with a new color. Leave enough space for subsequent images.
2. Stamp the Tiny Snail tape in teal.
3. Stamp the Tiny Peg Stamp in brown. Color in the rubber part with a rusty red pencil.
4. Stamp the Tiny Scissors in yellow and again in black.
5. Stamp the Tiny Ink Cubes in lime green and again in red.
