Step-by-Step Instructions

1. Stamp the Bee Skep in pinecone in the center of the card.
2. Create a border around the card by stamping the Tiny Chamomile Flower Small in black, filling in center of flowers with yellow pencil. Use the StampRight™ placement line to determine the position of the image. Clean the stamps each time before re-inking them with a new color. Leave enough space for subsequent images.
3. Stamp the Tiny Chamomile Open in black, filling in center of flowers with yellow pencil.
4. Stamp the Bitty Chamomile Budding in black, filling in center of flowers with yellow pencil.
5. Stamp the Mini Chamomile Sprig in green tea.
6. Stamp the Bitty Buzzing Bee in black, filling in with yellow pencil.
