## Step-by-Step Instructions

1. Create a border around the card by stamping the Mini White Clover Leaf in green tea. Use the StampRight™ placement line to determine the position of the image. Clean the stamps each time before re-inking them with a new color. Leave enough space for subsequent images.
2. Stamp the Tiny Red Clover in pink.
3. Stamp the Tiny Red Clover again in lilac.
4. Stamp the Tiny Crimson Clover in cardinal.
5. Stamp the Tiny Crimson Clover again in burgundy.
6. Stamp the Tiny Fern Filler in pinecone.
7. Stamp the Tiny Busy Bee in black, filling in with a yellow and brown colored pencil.
