Step-by-Step Instructions

1. Stamp the Mini Watermelon in green. Use the StampRight™ placement line to determine the position of the image. Rotate the stamp between impressions. Clean the stamps each time before re-inking them with a new color. Leave enough space for subsequent images.
2. Stamp the Tiny Watermelon Tendril in brown at each end of the Watermelon.
3. Stamp the Tiny Watermelon Wedge in red.
4. Stamp The Tiny Watermelon Slice in red.
5. Stamp the Tiny Watermelon Leaf in green.
6. Stamp the Tiny Watermelon Seeds in brown.
7. Coloring the watermelon rinds with a green colored pencil is a nice touch to finish off the project.
